Assessing Readiness for Connected & Automated Vehicles: This course is intended for transportation professionals/agencies that are already familiar with introductory connected and automated (CAV) concepts and are beginning to plan implementation of a CAV environment. The overall goal of this course is to teach participants how to develop an action plan in collaboration with regional partners to improve readiness for CAV deployment. Participants will learn more about the technological components required for CAVs, the hardware/software being deployed at the CV Pilot sites, and overall lessons learned from the procurement and installation phase of the three pilots. Lastly, they will be made aware of recent activities supported by the ITS Joint Program Office and resources available from the CV research program sponsored by the U.S. DOT. Instructors will be Ed Fok, FHWA Resource Center and Gustave Cordahi, Booz Allen Hamilton.

1 to Rector Street; 2 or 3 to Wall Street; 4 or 5 to Bowling Green; J or Z to Broad Street; R to Whitehall & Rector Street. You may take the M15+ Select Bus to Water Street & Wall Street; M15 Bus to Broad Street & Water Street; M20 to Battery Place & Washington Street.

Driving Directions:

From the GWB (George Washington Bridge)

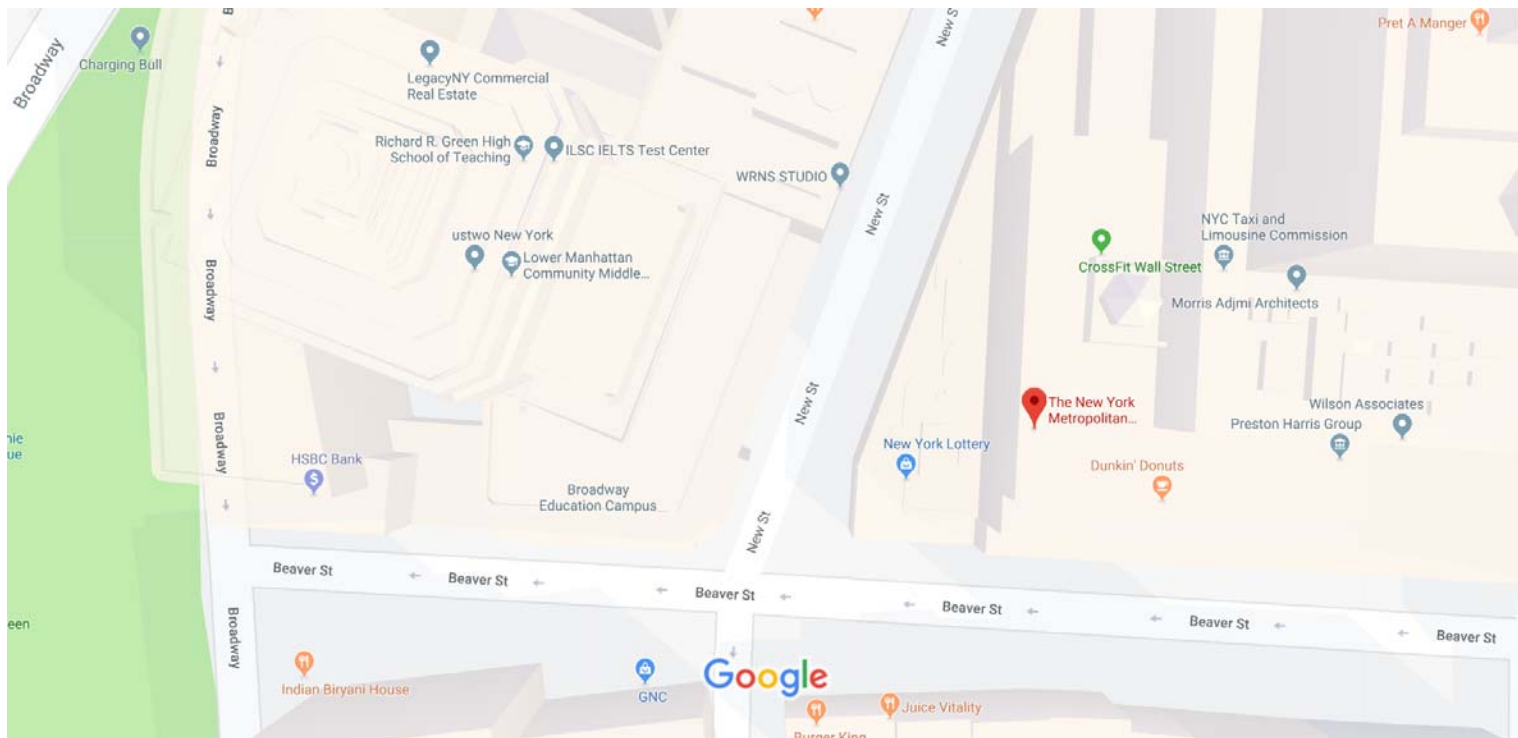
1. Merge onto I-95 N/US-1 N/US-9 N (Crossing into New York)
2. Take the Henry Hudson Pkwy Exit 1, toward NY-9A/W 178 St
3. Keep right to take the NY-9A/Henry Hudson Pkwy ramp
4. Keep left at the fork in the ramp
5. Merge onto NY-9A S toward Downtown
6. Take West St toward NY-9A S/Battery Park
7. Turn left onto Battery Place
8. Turn right to stay on Battery Place
9. Turn slight right onto State St.
10. State St. becomes Water St.
11. Turn left onto Broad St.
12. Turn left onto Beaver St.
13. **End @ 25 Beaver Street, New York, NY 10004**

From the LIE (Long Island Expressway)

1. Take I-495 W/Long Island Expressway towards New York
2. Take Exit 17W toward I-278 W/Bklyn Queens Expwy/Brooklyn/48 St.
3. Merge onto I-278W/Brooklyn Queens Expwy/Queens Midtown Expwy S towards Brooklyn
4. Merge onto Tillary St. via Exit 29 toward Manhattan Bridge/Bklyn Civic Center
5. Turn right onto Brooklyn Bridge Blvd/Adams St.
6. Adams St. becomes Brooklyn Bridge/Brooklyn Bridge
7. Take the Pearl St./FDR Drive ramp
8. Keep left at the fork in the ramp to take the Pearl St./FDR Drive S ramp
9. Turn right onto Pearl St.
10. Pearl St. becomes Water St.
11. Turn Right onto Broad St.
12. Turn left onto Beaver St.
13. **End @ 25 Beaver Street, Suite 201, New York, NY 10004**

From the RFK Bridge (formerly Triboro Bridge)

1. Going East Take I-278 East/Robert F Kennedy Bridge
2. Take Exit 46 towards Manhattan/Randalls Island
3. Keep left at the fork of the ramp
4. Merge onto RFK Bridge
5. Take the ramp toward FDR Drive South
6. Keep right at the fork in the ramp
7. Merge onto FDR Drive S.
8. Take Exit 1 toward Battery Park/Staten Island Ferry
9. Merge onto South St.
10. Take the 1st right onto Broad St.
11. Turn left onto Beaver St
12. **End @ 25 Beaver Street, Suite 201, New York, NY 10004**
