Tunnels, Bridges and Terminals Department Facilities Operations

The Tunnels, Bridges & Terminals Department operates four bridges, two tunnels, a bus terminal and a bus station and collects over 1.3 billion in revenues each year. This is an exciting time to join Tunnels, Bridges and Terminals (TB&T) as the department embarks on several projects that will re-shape transportation in the region including, the raising of the Bayonne Bridge, rebuilding the Goethals Bridge and the implementation of an all-electronic tolls system.

JOB TITLE: Principal, Program Manager

LOCATION: World Trade Center, New York City

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Reporting directly to the General Manager, Tunnels, Bridges, & Terminals Operations Services, the Principal Program Manager is responsible for maintenance and operational support for Tunnels, Bridges, and Terminals (TB&T) facility information technology systems that deliver mission critical and life-safety functions for the department and the agency. These systems include, but are not limited to: video systems, traffic management systems, incident management systems, access control systems, and industrial control systems (SCADA). Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Manage the maintenance and operational support of TB&T's traffic, industrial control and security systems. Ensure system availability and reliability of these systems to support delivery of mission critical and life safety functions.
- Coordinate contract maintenance of systems and numerous field devices and equipment, ensuring compliance with contractual standards for response time and quality, and diagnostic and troubleshooting activities.
- Scope and manage extra work projects, including design, development, installation testing, and system acceptance.
- Generate preventative and corrective maintenance plans and schedules in coordination with the facilities
- Oversee all aspects of contract management and administration for systems
- Lead and/or assist on Departmental initiatives and special projects as requested.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor Degree in Engineering, Computer Science, Business Management or a related discipline from an accredited college.
- A minimum of three (3) years of experience in the operation and maintenance of mission critical information systems and contract management, and two (2) years of supervisory/management experience.
- Demonstrable hands-on experience recommending and implementing physical and security technology solutions
- Must possess a valid driver's license and capable of driving Port Authority vehicle when required.

DESIRABLE:

The ideal candidate will present the following qualifications profile:

- Understanding critical infrastructure information and ability to use sound judgment to assess, and evaluate.
- Working knowledge of Security Systems, Intelligent Transportation Systems, and Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition Systems (SCADA), computer servers, network systems, and associated field equipment.
