ITS-NY's 2012 *Best Student ITS Paper Competition* is open to graduate and undergraduate students of universities, colleges, and academic institutions in New York State. The Winner will receive special Award Recognition and will present the paper at the June 7-8, 2012 Nineteenth ITS-NY Annual Meeting and Technology Exhibition – New York's Premier Gathering of the ITS Industry, providing a great opportunity to meet and network with future Government, Private, and Academic Sector Employers!

**Prizes:** The Region II University Transportation Research Center will award the Winner a \$500 cash prize. Additionally, the winner will receive free 2012 ITS-NY Annual Meeting Registration, pre-approved travel reimbursement, and June 7, 2012 overnight stay plus dinner at the Gideon Putnam Hotel and Conference Center, Saratoga Springs, NY – the site of the 2012 ITS-NY Nineteenth Annual Meeting and Technology Exhibition. Annual Meeting Registration includes entry to all conference sessions and exhibits, and June 7-8, 2012 breakfasts, lunches, breaks and Special Reception. Winner will be responsible for preparing powerpoint slides about the winning paper, providing these slides in advance for review and approval, and then making the presentation during the ITS-NY Annual Meeting. Winner will also be responsible for making travel arrangements (reimbursable) to attend the Annual Meeting. ITS-NY will be responsible for the winner's conference registration, approved travel reimbursement, overnight accommodation and dinner.

**Paper Submission Deadline:** April 6, 2012

### What to Submit:

1. A brief paper (Word format, maximum 5 pages, single spaced, not including cover page) whose specific topic is of your own choosing and falls within the broadly defined category of Intelligent Transportation Systems, Services, or Programs in New York State, including ITS research which could positively impact New York State.
2. Include the following contact information on the cover page of your paper:
  - Applicant Name
  - University, Academic Year, Academic Discipline, Anticipated Graduation Date
  - Your Mailing Address, Telephone Number, and Email Address
  - Your Faculty Advisor's Name, Telephone Number, and Email Address
3. A copy of your non-official transcript (used for eligibility verification)
4. Submit all of the above by the April 6, 2012 deadline by email to the ITS-NY Administrator at: [Administrator@its-ny.org](mailto:Administrator@its-ny.org).
