




#### **Infrastructure Investment & Jobs Act Overview**

- \$1.2 trillion in total funding over
  5 years
- Invests in all 17 Report Card categories
- Addresses 43 recommendations in the 2021 Report Card
- The largest-ever investment in resilient infrastructure (\$50 billion+)
